GENERAL JOB DESCRIPTION

The Red and White Fleet is looking for a multi-skilled, professional individual for our Port Engineer whose general responsibilities will include vessel and facilities maintenance and repair, project management, materials procurement, budget management, and staff supervision. The Port Engineer reports to the VP of Operations.

Key Areas of Responsibility:

1. Oversees, executes, and maintains records of: preventative maintenance of vessel and facilities, emergency maintenance of vessels and facilities, and drydocks of vessels
2. Procures maintenance and cleaning supplies as well as other operational equipment.
3. Prepares and manages vessel and facility maintenance and repair budgets, engineering department annual budget, and assists in the research and development of the capital and long term budget projections for vessels.
4. Scopes projects, obtains project bids, negotiations price, oversees work performance, and signs off on completed projects when working with outside maintenance contractors and shipyards.
5. Leader in training, audits and observance of safety, security and environmental policies and procedures
6. Audio equipment and alarm system maintenance
7. Staff supervision

SPECIAL CONDITIONS/REQUIREMENTS:

A pre-employment physical and background check is required. Applicants must provide proof of U.S. citizenship, or authorization to work in the United States within three days from the date of hire.

PHYSICAL AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS:

Work site requires climbing up and down ship ladders and gangways; lifting and carrying material from pier to vessels, and occasional work in excess heat, cold, dampness or dry atmospheric conditions.

All applicants should be capable of working in cramped spaces on rolling vessels, maintaining balance on a moving deck, rapidly donning an exposure suit, stepping over doorsills of 24 inches in height, opening and closing watertight doors that may weigh up to 56 pounds, pulling heavy objects, up to 50 lbs. in weight, distances of up to 400 feet, climbing steep stairs or vertical ladders without assistance, participating in firefighting and lifesaving efforts, including wearing a self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA), and lifting/controlling fully charged fire hoses. Extended workdays are common.
