Prices are \$36 for adults (18+); \$24 for youth (5-17); or a family pass for only \$89 (good for two adults and up to four youth). Add Red and White Fleet’s “Hop on, Hop Off City Loop” tour, which includes transportation to the California Academy of Sciences, for an additional \$30 per adult or \$13 per youth, when purchased together with the Explorer Cruise. The California Academy of Sciences: the number one cultural attraction in the city is home to an aquarium, planetarium, natural history museum, , and four story rainforest under a 2.5 acre living roof.
